

North League Rules

1ST/2ND GRADE

GAME TIME

- Game will be 55 minutes, no new inning at 50 minutes.
- In the case of rain, if 3 innings or 35 minutes have been played, it will constitute a full game.
- An inning is over when all players have batted once.
- No Forfeits will be enforced. Organize the games with the players that are present.

DEFENSE

- Each team will be allowed to play all players on defense, with extra players in the outfield.
- The defensive pitcher will be allowed to be within 4 feet of the pitcher (coach), even with, but not in front of.
- Each coach will pitch to his/her team.
- No catcher is needed. But can be used. An Assistant/Parent Volunteer will be used.
- No infield fly rule will be called.

BASE DISTANCE

- Pitching Mound is where ever the coach needs to pitch from.
- Base Distance 50 ft.

BATTING/OFFENSE

- All players will bat through the batting order once per inning.
- 1st Grade (Beginning Coach Pitch): Each player will receive 5 pitches. After 5 the player will hit from a tee that will be provided.
- 2nd Grade (Advanced Coach Pitch): Each player will receive only 6 coach pitched pitches
- No Bunting.
- All base running rules apply. If you are called out, you must go back to the sidelines. If a child is having a hard time not wanting to go back to sidelines, it's okay for them to stay, but try to teach them that they need to.
- You may advance as many bases you can off your hit.
- No Stealing. Players can only advance on a hit.
- If on third, the only way to advance home is to be hit in or played on.
- Runners can advance one base on an overthrow.
- All base runners must wear a protective helmet.
- A safety ball is used.

SCORES
