





BURN PERMITS

Burn permits will be issued by the North View Fire District throughout the month of April. You can obtain a permit from our office or from the fire station located at 315 E 2550 N. For those in a residential area please note that your fire must be a minimum of 50 feet from any structure i.e. home, shed, fence. **If you do not have the minimum clearance you cannot burn.**
