PUBLIC NOTICE

EVIDENCE DISPOSAL SET FOR JULY 16, 2014

The Harrisville Police Department has items which have been taken into custody that will be donated, destroyed or otherwise eliminated effective July 16, 2014. These items include the following: Backpacks, luggage, bags, purses, wallets, bags, clothing, credentials (Social Security cards, identification cards, credit and debit cards, passports, etc), knives, cell phones, jewelry, hand and power tools, bikes, ski equipment, helmets, electronic equipment, and miscellaneous papers.

If applicable, reasonable attempts have been made to contact the owners by U.S. Mail.

This is not an open call for the review of lost and found items by the general public. Rather, the department invites individuals with reason to believe any of the above items are theirs to contact the Police Department at (801) 782-4100.

POLICE NOTE

Please be mindful while you are searching the web for deals on products or even answering classified ads; regardless whether they are in a newspaper or on any website. Consumer Reports recently stated that the internet marketplace is full of counterfeit products and advertisements. As a consumer you need to make sure the sites you are visiting are selling legitimate products. In regards to classified ads, never provide personal information such as your full name, date of birth, address or phone number in an initial e-mail. No bank, credit card company or potential employer will call and ask for your personal or account information. If a caller asks for this information, it's most likely a scam. If someone wants you to cash a check and return part of it with a wire transfer, it's a scam. Remember that you are responsible for damages when you cash a money order or cashier's check for a third party and the check is found to be fraudulent. -Detective Dennis Moore

WATER CONSERVATION TIPS

FUN WATER FACT Approximately 85 percent of U.S. residents receive their water from public water facilities. The remaining 15 percent supply their own water from private wells or other sources.

INDOOR WATER CONSERVATION TIP Don't flush things down the toilet to dispose of them. Throw away tissues and other bathroom waste in the garbage can, which doesn't require gallons of water. (The average person in the United States uses anywhere from 80-100 gallons of water per day. Flushing the toilet actually takes up the largest amount of this water.)

OUTDOOR WATER CONSERVATION TIPS Apply water only as fast as the soil can absorb it. Avoid watering between 10 am - 6 pm and when it is windy. Water dry or brown spots in your lawn by hand. Use a hose rather than running your sprinkler system. This will take care of the brown spots while saving thousands of gallons of water and not over watering the rest of the entire lawn to take care of the same brown spot.
