Harrisville City is proud to announce a new, local event. Our very own Farmers Market! The Market will take place Thursday evenings at Harrisville City Park (1350 North Highway 89) from 5:30-8:30 p.m. starting July 16th and running through September 3rd. There will be local vendors of food, crafts, art and more. Participation is encouraged by becoming a vendor and registering through our website.

Booth fees are either \$10 a night or \$75 for the season and are paid through the city office. All booth registration fees must be paid before July 10th, 2015 to be guaranteed a booth, no season discount is available after this date. Booths are available after this date on a weekly basis. Information packets will be available online for download or in print at the city office.

If you are interested in providing musical entertainment, you may also apply at the city offices. Entertainment will not be charged a fee for participation as a vendor, and will be on a volunteer basis. Harrisville City Farmers Market is also looking for volunteers to help staff the event on Thursday evenings. All volunteers are appreciated and will be contacted as needed. Natural Hazard Pre-disaster Plan

All government entities in Weber County are cooperating to prepare the 2015 Natural Hazard Pre-disaster Mitigation Plan. This Plan is to help identify risks and reduce the vulnerability to natural hazards in the county. Some of the natural hazards identified for our county include: earthquake, flood, drought, landslide, wildfire, dam failure, severe weather, pandemic, and insect infestation. Flooding is one of the biggest risk to our city. A portion of our city is located in the flood plain. According to FEMA, developing and purchasing land in (and close to) the floodplains may create huge financial loss to developers and property owners. Development in the floodplains also creates enormous financial problems for communities. Understanding natural hazards, such as flood risks and floodplain management, saves money and prevents unnecessary loss of life, property, and environment. Residents are encouraged to participate in the natural hazard planning process. Please feel free to contact city staff or submit your comments in writing relating to the draft Plan by August 30, 2015.

Vote by Mail

For the 2015 Municipal Election year, Harrisville City is making voting as convenient as possible for its residents.

This year, Harrisville City will be delivering a ballot to every registered voter's mailbox, in addition to hosting a traditional polling place at the Harrisville City Offices. Residents may either mail their ballot back, drop it off at a secure drop box inside the City Recorder's Office, or vote a paper ballot on Election Day at the Harrisville City Offices.

We recognize that giving voters choices is an important part of engaging an informed electorate. We also acknowledge that there is still a portion of the population that feels it is important to participate in their democracy on Election Day in person.

In addition to giving people more choices, this combined by mail and in-person option will allow the County to prolong the life of their aging voting machines. The current machines are sorely outdated and are increasingly expensive to repair and maintain. Harrisville is proud to offer choice and convenience to its residents.

Planning Commission Vacancy

Open Candidacy Period

Candidates shall file a Declaration of Candidacy in person with the City Recorder at the City Offices, 363 W. Independence Blvd., Harrisville, Utah, during office hours and not later than the close of normal office hours between June 1 and June 8. A Nomination Petition may also be filed during the same time period. City office hours are Monday through Thursday, 8am to 5pm and Friday, 8am to 12pm. Filing fee is \$25.
