HARRISVILLE "DISC GOLF" COURSE GRAND OPENING

Harrisville City and Infinite Discs are sponsoring the first disc golf tournament at the new grand opening of the Harrisville City Disc Golf Course on Saturday May 24th.

Grand Opening Format: This day will be divided into two separate events. Both include a free golf disc with a custom Harrisville stamp, and lunch provided by Pier 49 Pizza!

Recreational Morning Round: 9:00am.- Beginner & Recreation Player Check-in and Registration. Come at 9:00 to help organizer. After registration and check-in you are welcome to play casually until the players meeting and rules explanation at 9:45. 10:00am-Beginner Recreational Play Begins. Come have fun playing 9 holes as you play with an experienced disc golfer who will teach you the technique, rules, and etiquette. Cost is \$10. Registration is limited to 36 participants. Registration

includes a free disc. 11:30 Lunch is included for anybody in attendance that day. Those disc golfer with more experience will register during the 11:30-12:30 time frame. Experienced Player Afternoon Competitive Play: 12:00 pm. – Experienced Players Check-in. 1:00 pm. Experienced Players Tournament. Following lunch, a singles 18 hole disc golf tournament will be played (two rounds of 9 holes). There will be intermediate, Advanced, and Open divisions, with prizes and cash payout for all levels. Cost is \$25. Registration is limited to 45 participants. Registration includes a free premium disc golf disc, and you will be eligible for additional prizes and cash payout. Advanced divisions will have more aggressive payouts (winners take more, and fewer people take anything).

ELECTIONS 2014 • EARLY VOTING

The 2014 Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 24th. Early Voting will take place at six locations: Marriott-Slaterville City Hall, North Ogden City Offices, Ogden Valley Branch Library, Roy Municipal Building, South Ogden Municipal Building, and The Weber Center. Early Voting will be held June 10 – June 13 from 8:00 AM-Noon and June 16 – June 20 from 1:00 PM-5:00 PM. Any eligible Weber County resident, who has registered on, or prior to June 9th, will be eligible to vote early. Early Voting is a great way to avoid lines at the polls on Election Day.

VOTE CENTERS

Any registered Weber County voter may cast a ballot at any Vote Center located within Weber County on Election Day, regardless of precinct assignment. Voters who receive vote by mail ballots may also drop off their ballots at a Vote Center, or their assigned precinct.
