Winter is here! Please remember the winter parking ordinance remains in effect until April 1st with no parking on city streets between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Adhering to the parking ordinance helps our Public Works Dept. keep our streets clear and safe during winter months.

Remember, vehicles parked on the road during or after a snow storm impede snow plowing and may be towed at the owner's expense. Home owners are responsible to remove snow from sidewalks in front of their home and private driveways. Although it can be inconvenient

to remove snow pushed in front of driveways by the snow plows, our drivers cannot prevent this. Please avoid pushing/shoveling snow back into the roadway after it has been plowed. ## State of the City 2011

I appreciate the opportunity to reflect over the past year and share some of the accomplishments for Harrisville City and give you a look at what is planned for 2011. I'm sure the issue at the top of everyone's mind is the state of the economy and how it is impacting our City. I'm pleased to report that we just completed another successful independent audit where we were once again congratulated by the auditors for being free of debt. However, the economic climate continues to remain uncertain. It is still a time for conserving, caution, and common sense. Fortunately, there is no tax increase anticipated from the City this year but there will be fee increases for Bona Vista Water District and Central Weber Sewer Improvement District.

I want to share with you some of the highlights of what we as a City – with the collective efforts of the City Council, City Staff, and volunteers in the community – have achieved for Harrisville over the past year and what is planned for the year ahead.

We have continued the tradition of fun and successful community events such as our annual Heritage Days, Easter egg hunt, Santa at the cabin and our popular youth sports programs. Infrastructure inspections and

improvements by Public Works have included street maintenance projects, sidewalk replacement, and sewer and storm drain projects. Despite a 20% increase in calls for service this past year our Police Department continues to maintain a high standard of public safety with a focus on youth drug and alcohol prevention programs. The administrative staff has also worked hard to better serve the growing number of residents while maintaining the same level of staffing.

We have completed our 2010 goals of establishing community history and forestry programs, updating our Storm Water Management Plan, Emergency Operations Plan, and the transportation and pathways element of our General Plan. Our focus for 2011 will be the completion of a splash pad and upgraded softball field in the main park. Grant money obtained through Weber County RAMP funds combined with park impact fees collected from developers will allow us to complete these park projects.

It has been a pleasure and honor to work with so many wonderful people. I thank all of you for your efforts in making this a great place to live and look forward to all that we will accomplish together in 2011.
