NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Harrisville City Council will hold a public hearing on July 12, 2016, at 7:00 p.m., in the Harrisville City Office located at 363 W. Independence Blvd, Harrisville, Utah. The City Council has received a request from the new developer to amend the development agreement relating to Golf View Townhomes Phase 2, located at approximately 250 West 2000 North, Harrisville, Utah. This amendment changes the exterior design and other aspects relating to the Golf View Townhomes Phase 2. The City Council will take public comment in support and opposition to the proposed amendment. Economic Development Strategic Plan

For the past several months, Better City has assisted Harrisville City in preparing a Economic Development Strategic Plan. Better City volunteered to prepare this Plan as a volunteer project at no cost to the City.

In preparing the Economic Development Strategic Plan, Better City has made recommendation relating to future development projects. Among the recommendations is to include mixed-use type development in Harrisville City. This is in order to accommodate the increase costs associated with operation of local government and for providing a diverse housing supply for residents in Harrisville.

Harrisville City will be continuing its update of the City's General Plan to incorporate mixed use. The Planning Commission held a public hearing to proceed with the General Plan update. Your participation is requested. Harrisville City is concerned with the growth projected showing that by the year 2025 there may be a \$428,417.00 budget deficit if the Economic Development Strategic Plan is not implemented.
