# CELEBRATION TIME CAPSULE

## A CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

A 25-year time capsule will be put together as part of Harrisville City's 50th year Jubilee celebration. It will be scheduled to be opened at the 75th year celebration of the city's incorporation in 2037.

This time capsule will be buried in the ground near the city office building. We invite families to submit one standard 8 x 11 page that will go into a binder that will be placed in the capsule. Single individuals may also submit one page. On the page, you may include your thoughts about the past 50 years, or about what is happening today in the city and world, or your speculations about the future, inventions, etc. You may include pictures of your home and family. Be as creative as you like with your page or keep it simple.

We hope a lot of you will respond and be a part of history. We will be including electronic artifacts used in today's world such as an ipod, cell phone, MP3 player, camera, etc., (not in working order).

If you have any of these items, we are accepting donations. All pages and submissions must be received at the city office by July 20, 2012. The time capsule will be buried after Heritage Days as part of the city council meeting agenda on August 14, 2012.
