## WINTER PARKING

Winter is near! Please remember the winter parking ordinance begins November 1st and remains in effect until April 1st with no parking on city streets between the hours of 12:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. Adhering to the parking ordinance helps our Public Works Dept. keep our streets clear and safe during winter months. Remember, vehicles parked on the street during or after a snow storm impede snow plowing and may be towed at the owner's expense. Home owners are responsible to remove snow from sidewalks in front of



their home and private driveways. Also, please remove garbage cans from the road shoulder as soon as possible after collection.


