In order for residents normally serviced on the "Yellow Week" to transition to the "Green Week" schedule, your recyclables will be collected the week of August 26th and then again the week of September 2nd.

Thereafter, the recycling service will be provided every-other-week.

Please note that due to the Labor Day holiday on September 2nd, the collection of your trash and recyclables will be delayed one day.
