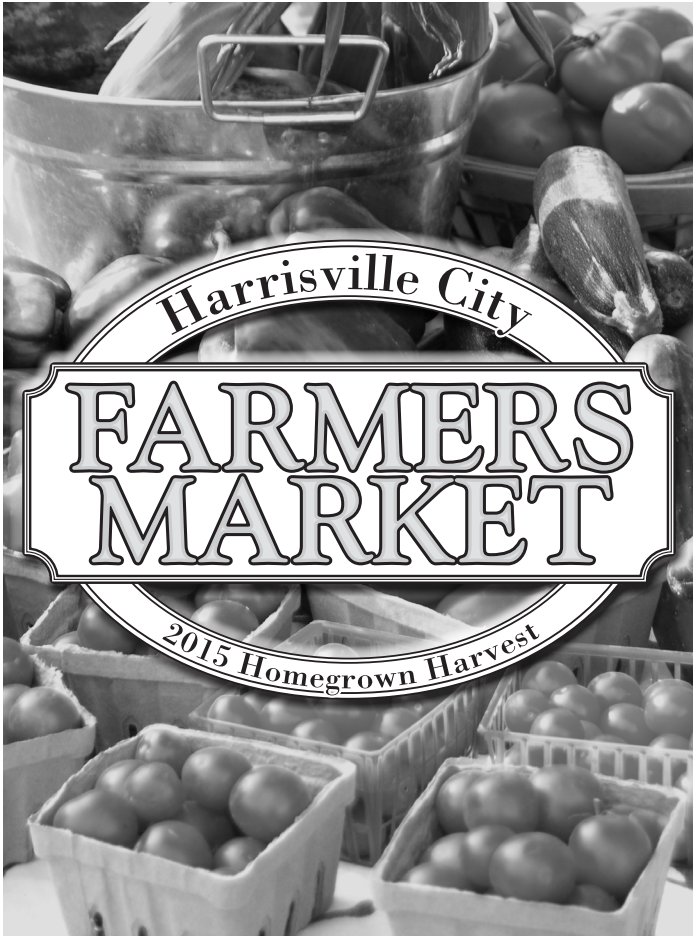

## Notice to Fill Midterm Vacancy in Municipal Office

In accordance with Utah Code 20A-1-510, notice is hereby given that Harrisville City will be accepting resumes from qualified registered voters in Harrisville City who desire to be considered to fill a midterm vacancy on the City Council. The unexpired term of this midterm vacancy will expire on December 31, 2015. Qualifications for consideration are: be a United States Citizen, be a registered voter of the municipality, and be a resident of the municipality for a period of 12 consecutive months immediately preceding the date of the appointment. Resumes must be filed in person at the office of the City Recorder during regular office hours (Monday-Thursday, 8am-5pm, Friday 8am-12pm) and not later than noon on May 8, 2015. Applicants will be interviewed and considered by the City Council during the regular meeting on May 12, 2015, at 7:00 pm at the Harrisville City Offices, 363 W. Independence Blvd, Harrisville, UT.

The Splash Pad will open on May 25th at 10:00 am for the summer season. Splash Pad hours of operation are 10:00 am to 8:00 pm Mon-Sat. Splash Pad season runs Memorial Day through Labor Day. The Splash Pad is located at our main park at 1350 N. Hwy 89.

### SEWER BACKUP INFORMATION:

The Harrisville City Public Works Dept. through routine maintenance and sanitary sewer internal inspections has noticed an increase in grease build up in the sewer mains which can be potentially hazardous. This requires additional cleaning and monitoring to avoid backups and can be easily prevented. Please do not dump any grease down your drains as well as other detrimental items. The following are some additional helpful hints to keep your sewer lateral and the main clear and functioning properly: How to prevent a backup: taking notice of what is flushed down toilets and sinks can prevent most backups. DO NOT flush the following materials (or similar items) down toilets/drains. These items can plug the main and cause damage to you and other property owners connected to the main. • Large quantities of toilet paper • Paper towels • Feminine napkins • Disposable diapers • Clothing – socks, underwear... • Plastic, metal, wood, etc. • Large quantities of cereals or grains (they can swell with water) • Live seeds, beans, and peas (they may sprout) • GREASE, FATS, OILS • Sand • Fibrous materials (cotton balls, hair, rags, cigarette butts...) • Sponges, scouring pads If a backup occurs: first take action to protect people and valuable property. You may call the city or special service district, and as a service we'll check the main sewer. Any blockages found in the main lines will be promptly cleared. If the main line is not blocked, we recommend that you call a plumbing or sewer contractor to check your lateral line. Maintenance and repair of the lateral serving the home is the owner's responsibility. Regardless of the location of the blockage, clean up of the home should be done as soon as possible to minimize damage and possible negative health effects. There are qualified local businesses that specialize in this type of clean up.

## NO SOLICITING

As the weather gets warmer, door-to-door solicitors will be making their rounds through the city. There are a few things residents should be aware of. All solicitors are required to be licensed by the city. Their license will be laminated with a picture ID, issued by Harrisville City, stamped with the city seal, and prominently displayed. Persons exempt from this would be those representing charitable or non-profit organizations, including students, or those disseminating religious or political information. Everyone must respect no soliciting signs and leave as soon as you voice your disinterest. Please help get the message out that anyone soliciting without a license in Har-
